### **CEO's Message October 2022**

The metaverse has arrived. Its implications because of the use of exponential technologies will be profound. Some of the technologies which Indus schools will adopt to improve student effectiveness will be:







### **Hindi Diwas**




### **Ganesh Chaturthi Celebration**



Water filtration is the process of eliminating or reducing the concentration of particulate matter from toxic water that can provide safe and clean water for a specific purpose. This comprises suspended particles, parasites, bacteria, algae, viruses, and fungi. During our three-minute presentation on their research, each student of Year 2 held up their charts and recited their lines as the other students listened closely.


This was our second chemistry project, and it necessitated a lot of teamwork as we were divided into groups. On Microsoft Teams, we all worked in groups and spoke about our responsibilities and who on the team required to get an earache. ### **MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (MYP)**




### MIDDLE YEARS PROGRAMME (MYP) Year 1 - Science








### **Tamhini Ghat**


Geography










### DIPLOMA PROGRAMME (IBDP1) Student Achievement -Ahaan






### DIPLOMA PROGRAMME (IBDP2) Theory of Knowledge Retreat- 24th and 25th September



### **Horse Show Jumping**


We are happy and proud to share that **Ronith** has qualified for participation in "Horse Show Jumping" in JNEC (Junior National Equestrian Championship) this year in December.


