Their efforts were showcased on Innovation Day which was held on the 2nd of October 2020.


What better day to celebrate innovation than on the birth date of Mahatma Gandhi?

Like all things virtual, we decided to celebrate student leadership virtually too.


Nothing is harder than being a leader in tough times and we are ever so proud of the outgoing council for being so resilient.



All papers were published an evening in advance and the examination team as well as Parent Advisory Committee Grade Representatives were on standby to ensure that all challenges were resolved in real time.




Winter Vacations - 18th December to 4th January 2021

Here is hoping that the New Year brings happiness and cheer and a hope that we will meet again.




