Achievements

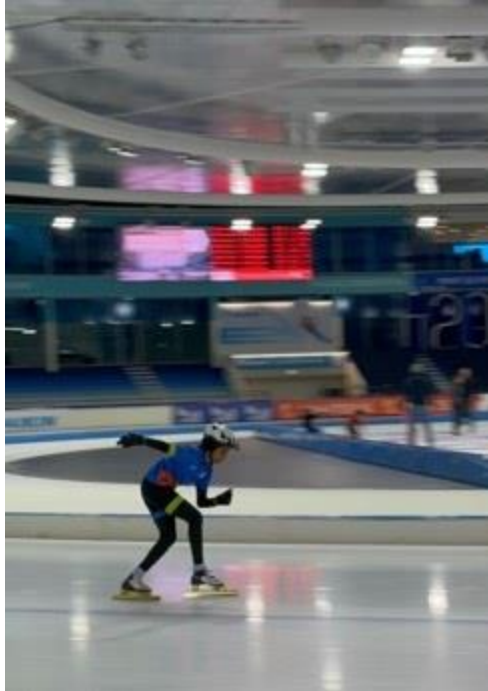

Extended Essay Orientation



The Extended Essay serves as an opportunity for our students to engage in independent research, fostering critical thinking and preparing them for the challenges of higher education. Being an integral part of IBDP curriculum, Extended essay orientation was conducted on December 15 by the Extended essay coordinator – Ms. Debosree Roy and DPC Ms. Jovella Dias. The orientation began with a comprehensive overview of the Extended Essay, emphasizing its significance in developing skills such as research, analysis, and academic writing. Students were introduced to the purpose of the EE and its alignment with the IBDP core principles. This was then followed by introducing different assessment criterions for completion of EE. Resources were shared via email with students to kick start the research on Extended essay.

Maintaining academic integrity is paramount in the Extended Essay. Hence, Academic Integrity was discussed at length with students to instill a strong sense of academic responsibility and ethical research practices. Students were made aware of the Statement from the IB about ChatGPT and artificial intelligence in assessment and education- [Statement from the IB about ChatGPT and artificial intelligence in assessment and education - International Baccalaureate® \(ibo.org\)](#) Students were advised to use AI ethically and with a lot of caution.

Students were given time to do some independent research on the subject and topic of their interest. After this, students got an opportunity to attend subject orientation for various subjects. At the end of the session, students were advised to do some independent research on 3 subjects during the winter break. EE Subject selection will happen in the first week of January. As we embark on this academic journey, we are confident that the Extended Essay will be a rewarding experience for our students.

An Entrepreneurial Mind



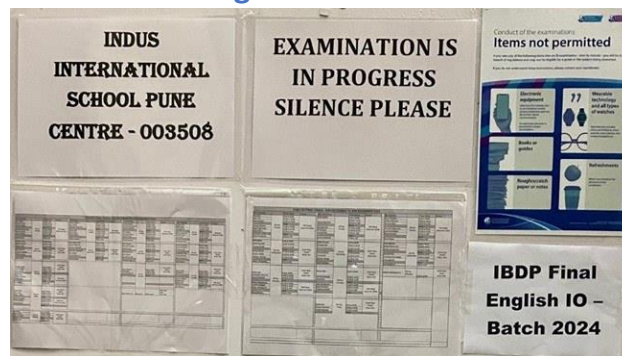

As the title suggests, Mohanish has successfully participated in and completed the ICode Global Hackathon 2023.

This journey started in April 2023 by winning the Scholarship of ICode Global Hackathon where Mohanish cleared basic levels of coding at school and interschool level. By August 2023, he had successfully advanced to the National Finals and secured 15th rank at India National Finals which opened the doors to Global Finale. The official email by hackathon@icode.org says, "Out of 70000 students that have registered for the competition only 8000 made it to the India National Finals, and Mohanish is one of the few who has made it to the Global Finals. The exam was conducted on 30th September, 2023. He secured 17th rank at the Global Finals (excluding China) and 96th rank at the Global Finals.

Collaborate to Conserve



We are glad to share with all of you that the innovative initiative “Collaborate to Conserve” on “Plastic Waste Management” achieved its fourth milestone on 12th December 2023. This student-led initiative, well guided by school faculty and supported by parents, collected another 20 Kg. of household plastic waste since August 2023. The same was handed over to Keshav Sita Foundation & Rudra Environmental Solutions for conversion to usable polyfuels.

“Collaborate to Conserve” for plastic waste segregation and management was launched in October 2022 by Grade 11 Students Ronith Lahoti, Rajveer Jadhav, and Grade 8 Student Arrsh Muttha. The initiative focused on creating awareness amongst fellow students and parents on domestic plastic waste segregation and collection. Collected domestic plastic waste is then sent for conversion to usable PolyFuel by Thermo Catalytic Depolymerization process, used for burning, heating, and power generation. The initiative has so far collected about 88 Kg of plastic waste in the last 1 year and 2 months. 23 Kg. from Oct. 22 – Jan. 23, 24 Kg. from Feb. 23 – May 23, 21 Kg. from Jun. 23 - Aug. 23, and now 20 Kg. from Sept. 23 – Dec. 23. The students have demonstrated that this noble initiative to care for the environment in our own small way is sustainable and here to stay. Strongly encouraging and urging all the students and parents to now scale up plastic waste management exponentially by committing to manage all domestic plastic waste responsibly through this initiative. There are further plans to become

a role model and promote collaboration to conserve the environment across many more schools in Pune this year.

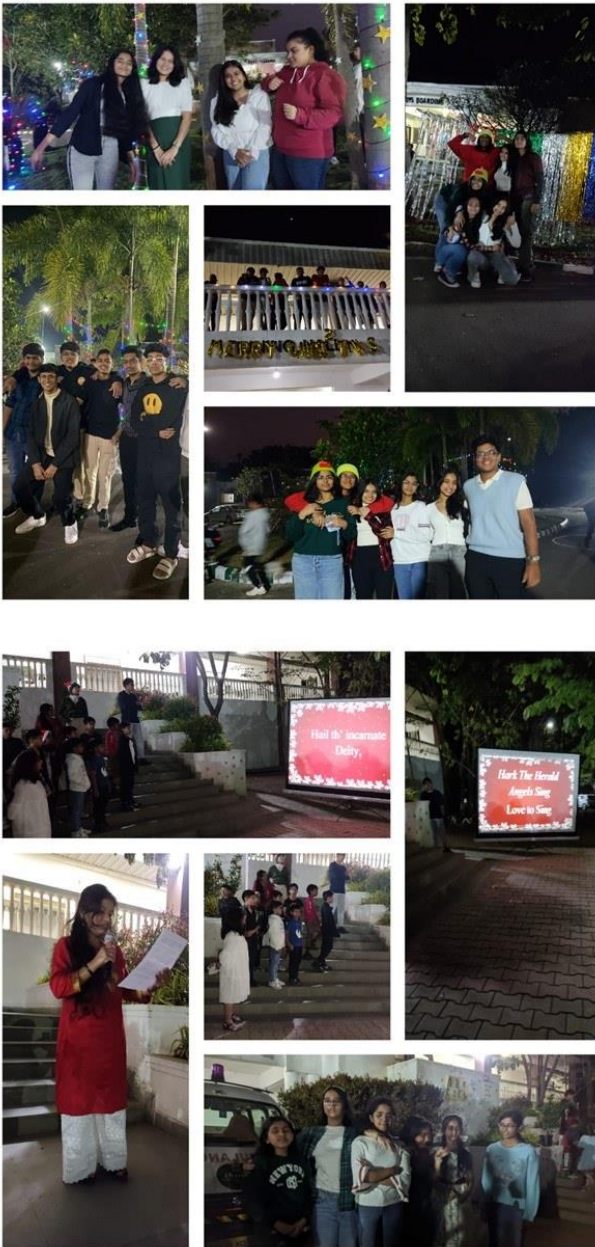
It's great to see students dedicated to their studies and preparing for the half-yearly exams. Hard work always pays off in academic success.
